Harvard Referencing Style

Known as the author-date style as each reference cited is characterized by the author's name and the publication date

Surname initials., Surname initials. & Surname initials., date, 'Name of Article', *name of journal*. Vol(number): page numbers

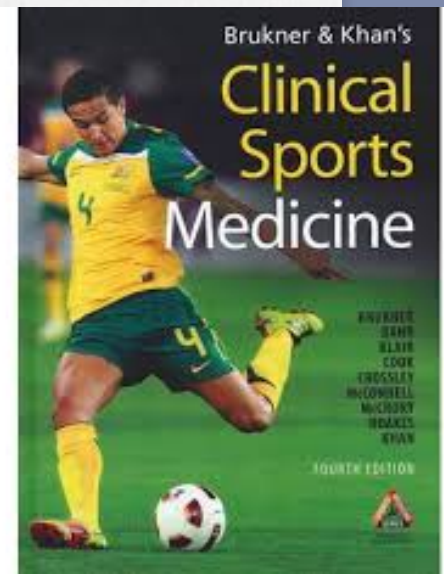
